



## Johann von Sporck

**Johann von Sporck (1600-1679)** – veteran of the Thirty Years War, initially he served in the Bavarian army and since 1647 in the Imperial army. Exceptionally talented cavalryman, during the Deluge he fought in Poland, Swedish Pomerania and in Denmark. From 1663 to 1664 he took part in the conflict with Turkey. Since 1670 he fought against Hungarian insurgents and from 1674 to 1675 against French and Dutch forces. While having no problems with leading 10 000 horsemen to battle he would not be able to command 300 musketeers.

## Special Rules:

### Veteran

The general will not be easy to surprise.

If he is the Commander in Chief then he may choose which side has the Initiative in the first Turn. If two or more Commanders in Chief have this rule then none of them may use it.

### Excellent Commander [cuirassiers]

Every turn the commander gains 1 additional Command Point that can be used to issue an Order to a cuirassiers Unit or can be transferred to a cuirassiers Unit commander.

### Poor Commander [infantry]

You must spend an additional Command Point when giving an Order to infantry Units of Regiments. You must also spend an additional Command Point in order to transfer a Command Point to a Commander of such Regiment.

### Initiative [+1]

He gets a +1 modifier to Initiative rolls.

Johann von Sporck replaces a general in the **Imperial Division in Poland and Denmark 1657-1660**. Division led by him may deploy all cuirassier regiments as "old" regiments.
